PSHE Healthy Education



- ❖ To know how to maintain, a healthy lifestyle including the benefits of physical activity, rest, healthy eating and dental health.
- ❖ To know how to use vocabulary to describe my feelings to others and develop simple strategies for managing them.
- ❖ To know how to keep physically and emotionally safe including responsible ICT use and online safety, road safety, cycle safety and safety in the environment, rail, water and fire safety?

SCIENCE Materials

- ❖ To know that Materials are the matter or substance that objects are made from.



- ❖ To know that we use a wide range of different materials every day. These might include: metal; plastic; wood; glass; ceramics; synthetic fibres; composites (made from two or more materials combined together.)

MUSIC



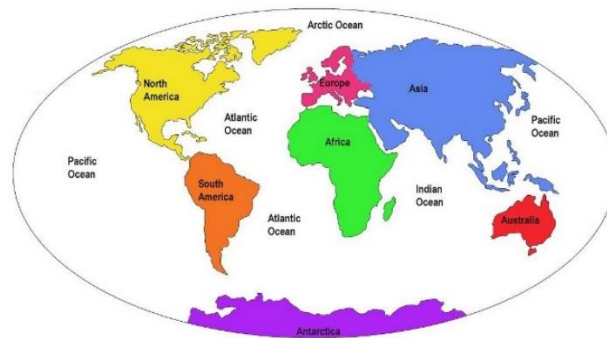
- ❖ To know that John Williams wrote the music for Superman and lots of other famous movies.
