History

- To know that Queen Victoria awarded the Royal Red Cross Medal to Florence. .She was the first person to ever be awarded this!
- To know that Florence Nightingale helped in the Crimean War by bringing over volunteer nurses to look after British injured soldiers. She worked in the Scutari Hospital in Turkey.
- To know that Florence had the nickname of 'Lady with the Lamp.'



PSHE
