PSHE



- To know how information and data is shared and used online

- To know that the same principles apply to online relationships as to face-to-face relationships. Including the importance of respect for others online including when we are anonymous.
- To know what peer pressure is.

Music



- To know that tempo, texture and timbre are elements of music.
- To know that types of sounds can be made and changed (timbres) and to spot when it changes in a piece of music.
- To know that we use the term 'tempo' to describe how fast or slow a piece of music is and to spot when it changes in a piece of music.
