To know a range of ways that cardboard can be joined

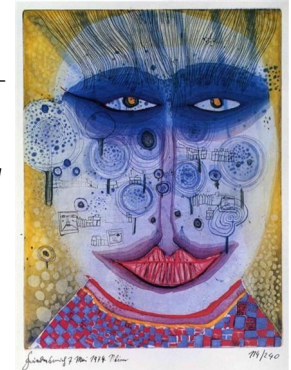
To know that scoring card ensures that it folds accurately
